# King Charles I School Equality Objectives 2015-16 review

The governing body adopted these short term objectives on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2015 and they were included in our action plans for the 2015-16 academic year. The review was discussed and agreed on The governing body adopted these objectives on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2016.

#### Objectives for the 2015/16 year

#### Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11

- 1. Improve the attainment and achievement of the boys so that the gap between the Progress 8 score of the boys and girls is substantially narrowed.
- 2. Improve the attendance of the females eligible for the pupil premium so that the gap between the attendance of these students and their peers is substantially narrowed.
- 3. Reduce the number of exclusions for boys so that the gap between the number for boys and that for girls is substantially narrowed.

### **Review: Objective 1**

The gap between the Progress 8 score of the boys and girls has slightly narrowed.

## **Review: Objective 2**

The attendance of the females eligible for the pupil premium decreased from 2014/15 to 2015/16 and so the gap with the boys increased.

Gap	-0.6	-1.8

#### **Review: Objective 3**

The number of exclusions for boys slightly reduced from 2014/15 to 2015/16 and so did the gap with the girls.
